



Intervention Ladder

The Intervention Ladder below depicts the disciplinary consequences resulting from a student committing a certain level of offense or the student's disciplinary record.

1. Level-1 offense committed for the first time results in a **verbal warning**.
2. Level-1 offense committed after 3 verbal warnings results in an **incident report**.
3. Three (3) incident reports obtained by Level-1 offenses result in a **30 minutes community service and a referral to the social worker**.
4. Additional two (2) incident reports obtained by level-1 offenses result in a **60 minutes community service**.
5. An additional incident report obtained by a level-1 offense results in an **in- school detention**.
6. An additional incident report results in a one day **in-school suspension**.
7. After three (3) detentions obtained by a level-1 offense, a **meeting will be scheduled with the parents and the social worker to discuss further actions**.
8. A Level-2 offense results in an **in- school detention** immediately.
9. After obtaining three (3) level-2 offense detentions, a **meeting will be scheduled with the parents for further actions**.
10. After obtaining a level-3 offense, a **meeting will be scheduled with the parents and the social worker for further actions**.

The school reserves the right to deprive any student with disciplinary misconduct from taking part in a certain school event, activity, or/and trip.
