

Anti - Stigmatization Policy



Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that all stakeholders develop a clear understanding of all matters related to COVID-19, including communication, data privacy, and clarifying misconceptions.

Definition

Stigma is the negative association between a person or group of people who share certain characteristics and a specific disease.

Roles & Responsibilities

Principal: The School Principal is responsible for enforcing this policy on all stakeholders and ensuring that they understand the importance of avoiding stigmatization of COVID-19 patients.

Teachers: Teachers are responsible for clarifying any misconceptions related to COVID-19 and for providing a safe and understanding environment for all.

Social Worker: The Social Worker is responsible for supporting COVID-19 patients by conducting general well-being sessions or one-on-one sessions.

Information Session

- The Social Worker assisted by the teachers, will conduct information sessions related to COVID-19.
- er will conduct Well-Being Sessions on how to deal with patients of COVID-19, including oneself.

- 3. The teachers will discuss the information shared by the Social Worker with the students and clarify any misconceptions.
- 4. The school will share with parents information videos related to COVID-19 facts and misconceptions as well as strategies to ensure and maintain emotional well-being.

Confidentiality

- 1. All information related to COVID-19 patients shall be kept confidential.
- 2. All information related to COVID-19 patients will only be shared with the patients and their teachers.
