Purpose

1. To have a policy on Positive Behavior including respecting others

2. To have a policy to address Bullying issues, should they occur

Policy

- 1. It is HPS/Br. policy to ensure Positive Behavior and respect
- 2. It is HPS/Br. policy to ensure that everybody enjoys school equally by feeling safe, secure, and accepted
- 3. It is HPS/Br. policy to address and handle any bullying attempt or act

Scope

HPS/Br. staff and students

Definition

Bullying: any physical, verbal or emotional abuse

Bullying can be, but is not limited to: pushing, shoving, hitting, spitting, name calling, picking on, making fun of, laughing at, insulting, threatening, and/or excluding someone

Procedure

- 1. Positive behavior including respecting others, setting an example, and discouraging bullying is expected of all administrators, staff, students, and parents
- 2. Any gesture that is expressed through written language, verbally, and/or physically that degrades a person is considered bullying

- 3. Abusive behavior will be considered bullying whether it takes place on school property or in a school vehicle
- 4. Any student or staff who chooses to participate in bullying will be met with a swift and severe consequence
- 5. Each observed/reported case of bullying will be studied and a disciplinary action will be decided on accordingly
- 6. Discipline will include strategies to correct the behavior, to prevent it from happening again, and to protect the bullied victim from further harm
- 7. Students/ staff (victims of bullying) are encouraged to immediately report any attempt or act of bullying
- 8. Students/ staff (who observe another student/staff being bullied) need to immediately report it to the school administration who will in turn report it to the authorities via the telephone hotline: **11611** and ADEC website:

- 9. Students/ staff who observe a bullying incident and fail to report it will be held accountable for not reporting
- 10. An Anti-Bullying agreement needs to be signed by the student/staff concerned.
- 11. School should report any incident that places a child in immediate danger to the police, and then to the Ministry of Interior- Child Protection Center within 1 hour of discovery.
- 12. All cases should be kept confidential (whether new or resolved).
- 13. School staff/students should comply with the guidelines of the ADEC Division in charge of Student Protection and article 272 of the UAE Law No.3 (1987)"Federal Penal Code".
- 14. School should raise awareness about bullying to both students/ staff members through training and workshops about bullying prevention and consequences.
- 15. School should provide orientation to parents at the start of every school year.

- 16. Students are supervised at all times.
- 17. Staff should sign and abide by the Student Protection Declaration Form.
